

NUGGET LAKE COUNTY PARK

This 752-acre semi-wilderness park offers a multitude of outdoor recreational opportunities. The main feature of the park is a 116-acre lake that winds for nearly two miles through a scenic forested valley. The park also features a spacious 55 site forested campground. The park also has a large picnic area with shelters.

The park also has an extensive hiking trail system that traverses over six miles of terrain. These trails explore several different natural ecosystems and forest types. The park also contains one of the most unique and interesting geological formations found in western Wisconsin. The geological formation is called Blue Rock and is part of the Rock Elm disturbance.
